



Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes for the period ending July 31, 2016

August 17, 2016 - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCQB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released monthly sales revenue and sales volumes results for the period ending July 31, 2016.

Sales volume, as measured by the surface area of product treated, increased 7% at 1,972,616 sq. ft. versus the 1,839,584 sq. ft. that was shipped in July 2015. Overall sales revenue generated for the month of July 2016 was off 7% relative to the revenue generated in July 2015 (\$715,013 vs. \$770,263).

Sales volume shipped into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly markets continued on a growth path with an increase of 47% over last July. Sales revenue into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly/Structural Insulated Panel market increased 49%. New distributors continue to be added through sales and marketing efforts in anticipation of the additional capacity that will be available once the new LP[®] FlameBlock[®] manufacturing line in Alabama comes on line later this year.

Sales into the Commercial Modular segment decreased 54% for the monthly reporting period with sales revenues correspondingly down 54%. The Commercial Modular market has been steady year to year, however, with July 2015 being the highest shipping month to the market in the entire year. The percentage drop in July is largely a result of the unusually high volume shipped to that market in July last year. Barrier anticipates sales volumes to Commercial Modular markets to continue on a track close in volume to last year, year to year. Barrier is keeping a close eye on substrate OSB prices, which are up relative to plywood. The difference in price between OSB and plywood substrate is an important component of competitive advantage for BlazeGuard[®] into the Commercial Modular market.
