



Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes for the period ending March 31, 2015

April 16, 2015 - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCQB; IBH: TSX-V), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released monthly, quarterly and year-to-date revenue and sales volumes results for the period ending March 31, 2015. Overall sales revenue generated for the month of March 2015 was \$746,339 vs. \$800,077. Quarterly sales volume (Jan-Mar) increased 16% from \$1,700,218 to \$1,964,934.

Total sales revenue generated for the fiscal year-to-date period (Jul-Mar) was \$6,273,996, a 17% increase from the \$5,376,090 generated during the same period ending in 2014. During the reporting period, sales revenue into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly market increased 24% and sales revenue into the Commercial Modular market increased 14%. Even though the revenues into the Commercial Modular market increased 14%, the corresponding substrate revenue for the Commercial Modular market (pass through) actually declined 1% over last year due to continued seasonably low OSB prices.

Total square footage of shipments to all markets for the month of March 2015, was 2,080,200 sq. ft. in comparison to 1,982,808 sq. ft. in March 2014 (5% increase). Overall shipments for the quarter increased 26% and shipments for the fiscal year-to-date July through March increased 23% (16,139,300 sq. ft. vs. 13,101,000). Of the total volume of shipments, sales into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly market grew 25% year-over-year, while shipments into the Commercial Modular market increased 18%.
