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## Monthly Sales Revenue and Sales Volumes for the period ending September 30, 2015

**October 19, 2015** - International Barrier Technology Inc. ("Barrier") (IBTGF: OTCQB; IBH: TSXV), a manufacturer of proprietary fire-resistant building materials has released monthly and quarterly sales volumes and sales revenue results for the period ending September 30, 2015. Shipments in September 2015 were 1,792,320 sq. ft. a 10% decrease over the 2,001,952 sq. ft. shipped September 2014. Of this total volume of shipments, sales into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly/Structural Insulated Panel markets decreased 14%, and shipments into the Commercial Modular market were up 1%. Quarterly square footage shipped (5,162,100 sq ft) decreased 19% over Q1 last year.

Overall sales revenue generated for the month of September 2015 (\$701,332) was 8% lower than the revenue generated in September 2014. Sales revenue into the Residential Roof Deck/Wall Assembly/Structural Insulated Panel market decreased 13% and Revenues into the Commercial Modular industry, increased by 10%. Overall sales revenue for the quarterly period July-September (\$2,206,462) decreased 11% over the same period in 2014.

Barrier believes decreases in shipments have been directly impacted more by production inefficiencies than demand over the past few months. Production efficiencies were impacted in a negative way by commitments Barrier made to produce Fire-Rated I-joist material. Order files remain solid and Barrier anticipates shipments will begin to approach levels consistent with last year once efficiencies are gained from experience with Fire-Rated I-Joist production.
